

BUDGET 2023/2024



Dear resident

It is my responsibility to set the part of your council tax that pays towards policing.

In determining the budget for 2023/24, I have taken into account a robust operational and financial case put forward by Chief Constable Pam Kelly and the results of a 11-week programme of public engagement with residents across Gwent.

This is always a difficult decision, made even

tougher by the worst cost of living crisis for 30 years.

However, the fact remains that almost half of Gwent Police's budget comes from local tax payers and, without an increase, cuts to essential services will have to be made.

I am confident that a rise of 6.82% (about £1.73 a month on average) remains affordable, while allowing Gwent Police to deliver the commitments

in my Police and Crime Plan, and continue to keep Gwent one of the safest places in the UK.

It will also enable Gwent Police to recruit 10 more Community Support Officers over the next year to serve our communities. These are in addition to the 170 new Police Officer posts we have invested in since 2016, and the 206 additional officers funded by the UK Government's Operation Uplift.

I would like to thank everyone that took the time to complete my survey and share their views.
