## CHURCH ROAD, RISCA EXPERIMENTAL ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ORDER 2024

**NOTICE** is hereby given that Caerphilly County Borough Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intends in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice to make the above order, the effect of which will be to:

Allow one-way traffic only along Church Road, Risca in a north westerly direction from its junction with Navigation Road to the junction with the unofficial car park area adjacent to the western side of St. Mary's Church.

The experimental order will be for a period of eighteen months during which time the Council is to consider whether the provisions of this Order shall continue in force indefinitely and the Head of Infrastructure acting on behalf of the Council may make any relevant changes as necessary, on safety grounds, or terminate the experiment if, in his opinion, the need arises within the first six months.
